She has also earned 8 other silver and bronze medals in individual and team events, many national and grand national titles for USTA and NBTA including Strut, Dance Twirl, Rhythmic Twirl, Solo, 2-Baton, 3-Baton, and Junior and Senior Dance Twirl Team/Twirl Team, as well as a 3-time title holder in the Miss America Organization. As Miss Park Cities 2018 and Miss Dallas 2019, she placed in the top 5 twice including first runner up at Miss Texas.
