ABTA MEMBERSHIP SUBSIDY PROGRAM - P5435

Objective of the Program:

- To support athletes who come from low income families by purchasing their ABTA Membership.
- Giving opportunities to children to our sport that couldn't normally afford the membership fees and therefore increasing our athlete membership numbers.
- Recruiting new members from low income communities.

Athletes - must be Type B (Pre-competitive) or can be Type A assuming they meet the following criteria:

- Athlete competes at the Pre-competitive level or is Level C in their individual events
- Does not compete in all individual events
- Does not compete in the Freestyle or Pair events
- Does not or will not be travelling outside of Alberta for camps/competitions
- Is unable to take advantage of any of the programs available within their Region (not Club level) for fundraising opportunities (ex. bingos, casino)

Clubs Chairs will submit all applications for this program to ABTA for consideration.

CLUB FUNDING

MEMBERSHIP

- ABTA will pay the Club/Region Registration Fee for the 2025-2026 season
- ABTA will pay for the Region Chairperson membership fee for the 2025-2026 season

CLUB RESOURCES (L5317)

- Funding is available from April 1, 2025 - March 31, 2026
- A maximum of \$200 per club
- Use the Club Promotion Funding document for more information on the funding requirements
- Funding may be used for:
 - * Creating a club website
 - * Website registration fees (for existing websites)
 - * Advertising your club (newspaper, social media, etc)
 - * Prop kits (scarves, bean bags, ribbons, etc)
 - * Club loaner batons (batons must stay within the club and not be sold)

SOCAN & RESOUND FEES - A5022

- ABTA will pay the SOCAN fee for each registered Club for the 2025-2026 season
- The SOCAN/ReSound fees are for regularly scheduled instructional classes only.
- If a club is holding an event that requires SOCAN/ReSound fees, they are responsible for the fees for their event.

6 WEEK LEARN TO TWIRL PROGRAMS (IN-PERSON) - L5339

- Aide clubs in gaining new members by offering funding to host a free 6 week program
- The 6 week program must be FREE program. The club cannot charge additional fees for this program.
- The organization and planning of this program is done by the Club.
- Clubs will be in charge of registrations, communicating with their participants, booking a facility, hiring a coach, submitting membership forms, sanctioning the program, etc
- Clubs will submit a funding form to ABTA at the completion of the 6 week program.
- Club must send ABTA the details of their course at least 3 weeks prior to the start date.
- ABTA will assist in advertising for the 6 week programs on social media.
- Classes must be offered for children ages 5 and up.
- Classes may be 45min - 60min.
- Class must have a minimum of 3 participants enrolled to be funded.

- Funds may be used for coaching fees, facility rentals and membership fees.
- ABTA will charge \$5.00 for the participant membership for this program.
- Each participant must have an ABTA membership prior to their first class.
- Coaching fee is \$40/class for the 6 week program.
- ABTA will fund up to \$40/hour for the facility rental fee.

- Participants may purchase a baton from ABTA for \$30 or borrow a loaner baton for the duration of the program. A \$30 deposit for the loaner baton will be required.
- Club can access Regional or ABTA loaner batons for their 6 week program.
- Program must be taught by a registered coach with a coaching level of CERTIFIED BATON TWIRLING FOUNDATIONS or higher.

- Funding is available until March 31, 2026
- Each club is eligible for a maximum of \$300.

ABTA OUTREACH PROGRAM (DAY CLINICS) - L5338

- Gain new members across the province by hosting 'Try Baton' day clinics
- Clubs to host clinics throughout the province that are open to the public to raise awareness about our sport and recruit new members.
- ABTA Coaches will volunteer their time to instruct at the clinic.
- Subsidize membership of new twirlers from clinics
- Maximum of \$300 per club to run a day clinic
- Clubs may only charge a maximum of \$20 registration fee
- Classes must be taught by a registered coach with a coaching level of CERTIFIED BATON TWIRLING FOUNDATIONS or higher.
- Programs will run between September 2025 - March 2026
- The funding program will be closed when the program budget has been reached.

CBTF SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM - P5402

- ABTA will pay for badges/pins that athletes earn through the CBTF Skills Development Program from April 1, 2025 - March 31, 2026
- Clubs must submit their badge test results with their request for reimbursement
- All badge test days must be sanctioned, even if they are being held during regular class time
- Clubs are not permitted to stock pile badges/pins

3. Current Vulnerable Sector Check (coaches & judges over 18; valid for 3 years)
4. Safe Sport Certification
5. Respect in Sport Certification
6. NCCP Certification (technical members)

TECHNICAL PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT - L5333

- Aide in the development of coaches and judges.
- To assist members of the ABTA Technical Association to attend seminars or courses held within or out of Alberta.
- This program also applies to the CBTF Coaching and Judging Programs.
- Technical members must submit a proposal to ABTA prior to the event/course for funding approval.
- Program will be closed for applications when the program budget has been reached.
- Funding is available until March 31, 2026
- Program budget: \$1,000
- The funding program will be closed when the program budget has been reached.

COACHES - FIRST AID CERTIFICATION - L5332

- All ABTA Coaches are required to have current First Aid Certification by November 30, 2025
- All ABTA Certified Coaches will be refunded 50% of the cost of their First Aid Course, up to a max of \$75.00
- Course must have been taken between April 2025 - March 2026 to be refunded
- Course must be a Standard First Aid Course with AED/CPR taken through Red Cross or St. John's Ambulance

COACHES - VULNERABLE SECTOR CHECK - L5327

- All ABTA Coaches who are 18 years or older are required to have current Vulnerable Sector Check by November 30, 2025
- All ABTA Certified Coaches will be refunded 100% of the cost of the Vulnerable Sector Check
- Coaches must submit their receipt and copy of their Vulnerable Sector Check result by using the online funding form: <https://form.jotform.com/251964196270261>

NCCP COURSES - L5332

- ABTA has funding available until March 31, 2026 for technical members who take the following NCCP courses:
“Making Ethical Decisions (MED)”
“Planning a Practice”
“Nutrition”
“Basic Mental Skills”
“Design a Basic Sport Program”
“Teaching & Learning”
- Once a course has been completed, the participant can submit their course receipt to ABTA for reimbursement. Technical Members are eligible for a maximum of \$100.

CBTF SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM APP - L5326

- ABTA has funding available from April 1, 2025 - March 31, 2026 for technical members who purchase the CBTF Skills Development Program App
- Once the app has been purchased, the technical member can submit the receipt to ABTA for reimbursement.
- 100% of the cost for the app will be reimbursed (max of \$40)
