General Information: Airdrie Sky High Twirlers created Tulip Twirl to provide our pre-competitive athletes with an additional local competition and another chance to move-up in their baton journeys. We added group events in 2025 and are now adding IBTF events (freestyle, pair and rhythmic) to our competition to give our athletes additional opportunities to perform.

Membership Requirements:

All athletes must hold a "Type A", "Type B,G" or "Type G" CBTF Membership in his/her provincial organization in order to participate in this competition.

**All athletes and their coaches must be registered current members in good standing of their own provincial organization and the CBTF. In order to compete, athletes must be coached by a certified CBTF Baton Twirling Foundations (BTF) coach who holds an active membership.*

Pre-Competitive Events - ABTA Ribbons



Open Groups - CBTF Medallions / ABTA Group Open Medals



Freestyle/Pair/Rhythmic Events - Pins to 5th place

Refund Policy:

Refunds will only be given for withdrawal from the competition for medical reasons. A medical certificate must be provided in order to receive refund.

NOTE: Athletes wearing tensor bandages, etc. at the competition are asked to provide a medical certificate PRIOR TO COMPETITION stating that the athlete can participate in the competition event. The Competition Director (in consultation with the Head Judge) has the authority to refuse to allow an athlete to compete if a medical certificate is not provided.

Music Requirements:



All music must be submitted electronically by coaches to ABTA using [this link](#).

All music must meet [CBTF tagging requirements](#)

All music will be played from one iPad at the competition

ERRORS or **OMISSIONS** on the entry form can be corrected via email.

CBTF Risk Management Policy:

1. The Competition Directors or Designates and/or the Head Judge will have the authority to stop the competition whenever a risk factor related to safety becomes evident.
2. If this situation occurs during individual competition, the competition on the lane where the situation occurs shall be stopped on that lane only by the Competition Director and/or the judge judging the event.
3. If the situation involves a medical injury or illness, the Competition Director in consultation with authorized medical personnel, shall determine whether the athlete(s) may be allowed to continue competing. The CBTF Risk Management Policy requires that a medical certificate is obtained before the athlete(s) is/are allowed to continue competing at that competition.

CANADIAN BATON TWIRLING FEDERATION (CBTF) RULES AND REGULATIONS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2026 WILL BE IN EFFECT AND STRICTLY ENFORCED.

JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL.

TABULATION RESULTS ARE CONSIDERED FINAL 48 HOURS AFTER ANNOUNCEMENT OR POSTING.
